IELTS Train the Trainer Workshop: Writing – IDP Education Ltd.

Abstract:

This IELTS professional development workshop has been developed by IDP IELTS Middle East in collaboration with a CELTA/DELTA trainer. This workshop is designed for teachers who are preparing students for the Academic version of the IELTS test. It raises awareness of the format of the IELTS test and task types, essential skills that are being assessed on the IELTS test, how these skills are assessed, and then links this understanding to effective practical strategies for teaching IELTS preparation in the classroom. This is an interactive workshop with a high degree of participant involvement.
